The Secondary School Implementation Working Committee will provide information and recommendations regarding reconfiguring all three high schools and the Education Centre to a grade 9-12 model to the Implementation Advisory Committee, Board of Education and Superintendent.

## **REPORT:**

Secondary Working Committee Meeting – January 18, 2018

#### 1. Considerations:

- GWG waiting for numbers
- CSS facilities, when will have answers on resources, counsellor and resource teachers concerned about increased numbers (double cohort), plan is for administrative involvement in transition
- SS facilities (where will the portables be accommodated), also concerns of counsellors in dealing with intake
- Ed Centre need to decide what to do at the middle school level and what the CHANCE and Ed Centre does for grade 9s, facilities
- Distance Education internal reconfiguration, waiting to find out what Distance Education will look like in September

## 2. Facilities

- CSS is trying to create space, need nine additional classrooms minimum
- SSs need to know where they are at regarding portables
- GWG need at least five portables, will be repurposing some rooms
- Need to confirm facilities by the end of January
- May move some portables from elementary and middle schools

## 3. Athletics After Reconfiguration

- Document presented that points out the issue. Reconfiguration can be negative or positive
- Recommendation hoping the district will allow charging of a small amount of money to member schools (per team in leagues, including non-Chilliwack public schools) to have an athletic coordinator in place to ensure a positive outcome
- Want to make sure that grade 9 students are not lost, that they have leagues and teams to participate in
- Grade 6s are heavily involved in athletics
- If we drop teams it will also effect other school districts (Agassiz, Hope)
- Parents expect a robust athletics program
- Who picks up the grade 9s if the coordinator stays at middle school?
- Reconfiguration will strengthen athletics
- District helping teacher for athletics?

## 4. Other

- Each school will send the district a list of additional resources required
- Timetables and course offerings need to be done by March 4-5
