POLICY
Board Self-Evaluation**

The Board of Education will review its performance annually to ensure its proper discharge of responsibilities to the community. The evaluation will be based on a positive approach which will indicate the Board's strengths and suggested areas for improvement.

The evaluation tool should meet local needs and provide for objective examination. Certain conditions are recommended to help the Board meet this goal and improve school board leadership. These conditions include:

1. Board member involvement in the development of standards by which they will evaluate themselves.
2. Holding the evaluation at a scheduled time and place such as a planning meeting or in camera meeting and with all Board members present.
3. Developing a composite of individual members' opinions and discussion of the results by a Board as a whole.
4. Supporting each judgment with as much rationale and objective evidence as possible.

Upon final discussion of the results, the Board will report to the public and develop an action plan to enable continued proficiency in its areas of excellence, to strengthen its adequate or weak areas and to eliminate those areas no longer applicable to its performance.
