POLICY  
Challenge for Credit**

---

The Board supports the concept of course challenge for credit by students provided there is evidence that they will succeed in the challenge, and that it is in their best interests. It is intended that challenge will be a rigorous process that will permit students to obtain full credits for a provincial or locally developed grade 10, 11 or 12 course through an assessment of a student's previously acquired prior learning elsewhere. Challenge is not intended as a way for students to improve their course marks, nor as a replacement for the valuable experience students gain by learning in a classroom setting. The Ministry of Education process outlined in its [policy](#) will be followed.
