



## AD Rundle Middle School Integrated Arts & Technology Cohort (6 – 8)

### Registration Information

- 1 Registration in the ADR Middle School Arts & Technology Cohort is open to any Chilliwack School District student who will be entering grade 6, 7 or 8 in September 2020. Priority will be given to FG Leary Fine Arts Elementary students transitioning to middle school.
- 2 Online applications for students entering Grade 6, 7 or 8 in September 2020 can be submitted online beginning January 20, 2020 by visiting <https://sd33.bc.ca/registration>.

**1. If A.D. Rundle is NOT your catchment school:**

- Select your catchment school; then select **YES** under the "I would prefer to attend a school outside my catchment area".
- Select AD Rundle Middle School as your first school of choice.

**2. If A.D. Rundle IS your catchment school:**

- Select A.D. Rundle as your catchment school, and click on *Next Page* to continue onto the next page of the application process.

**3. Continue through the application process. Ensure that you select Integrated Arts and Technology Cohort (6-8) in the Programs tab.**

**NOTE:** Current students of Chilliwack School District do not need to upload documents into E-Reg (birth certificate, proof of residence etc.). Select **No** under "Do you have all documents".

- 3 If the number of applications exceeds the number of spaces available, a lottery system for selection will be used. All applications received by March 31, 2020 will be included in this draw.
- 4 Applications after March 31 can be made [online](#) by selecting AD Rundle Middle School as your school of choice, and selecting AD Rundle Integrated Arts and Technology Cohort (6-8) under Programs. If space is not available, applicants will be added to the existing waitlist.
