

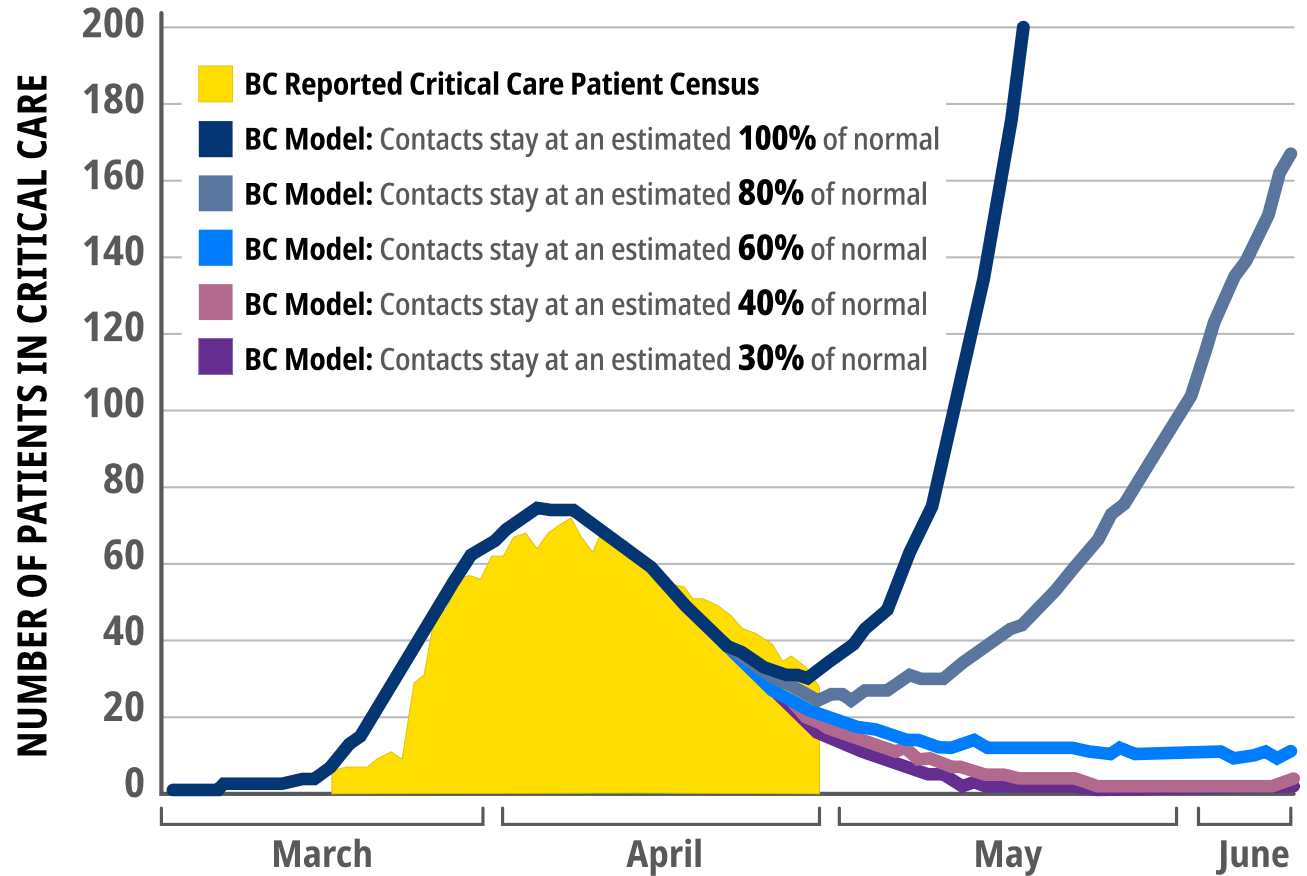

Four Phases Toward a 'New Normal'

Area of Action

Personal care

Social interaction

Economic Activity

Phase One (Today)

Essential Services Operating During COVID-19

- Enhanced resources for hospitals and health care.
- Child care for essential workers.
- K-12: Online and in-class learning.
- Non-essential businesses.
- Construction, manufacturing, agriculture, silviculture.

Five Principles For Every Situation

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Frequent handwashing• Cough into your sleeve• Wear a non-medical mask• No handshaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Routine daily screening• Anyone with any symptoms must stay away from others• Returning travellers must self-isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• More frequent cleaning• Enhance surface sanitation in high touch areas• Touch-less technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meet with small numbers of people• Maintain distance between you and people• Size of room: the bigger the better• Outdoor over indoor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spacing within rooms or in transit• Room design• Plexiglass barriers• Movement of people within spaces

Phase Two

Under Enhanced Protocols

- Small gatherings.
- Elective surgeries resume.
- Dentistry, chiropractic, physiotherapy, in-person counselling resume.
- Provincial parks will open for day-use.
- More retail businesses to re-open, supported by WorkSafeBC.
- Expanded in-person schooling for K-12 (voluntary).
- Legislature resumes.

Phase Three

Under Enhanced Protocols

- More parks open, camping resumes.
- Film and TV production.
- Movie theatres.
- Personal services like spas and non-medical massage.
- Hotels and resorts.

Phase Four (Treatment/Vaccine)

Conditional on at least one of: wide vaccination; “community” immunity; broad successful treatments.

- Large gatherings (rock concerts, conventions).

Principles and Values

- Strong health controls (testing, tracing, isolating).
- Strong border controls.
- Supporting local business.
- Standing together as a province.
