
RE: STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATE – IMAGINE HIGH VISIONING AND PLANNING

Goal	To increase students' abilities to apply critical, creative and reflective thinking.
Strategy	Establish New Integrated Arts & Technology School: Create a world class school for Chilliwack students at the secondary level in the area of integrated arts and technology.

# **Imagine High Visioning and Planning (Summer-Fall 2020)**

- Collaboration with graphic designer to create Imagine High Logo and motto
- Developed framework for learning experiences at Imagine High
