


K-12 Integrated Arts & Technology in SD33

As of September 2021, Integrated Arts & Technology choice programming at three sites:







 - Critical and Creative Thinking




FG Leary Elementary Integrated Arts and Technology Choice Stream

AD Rundle Middle Integrated Arts and Technology Choice Stream

- Registration opens February 1 for September 2021
- Up to 100 spaces at Grade 6 level
- Grade 7 and 8 now at capacity but waitlist open
- All FG Leary Grade 5 IAT students accepted into the ADR Cohort registration should be completed by March 12th
- Combined Grade 6, 7, 8 classes
- Integrating curriculum based on Project Based Learning
- Innovative learning spaces at: AD Rundle main site, Cohort Building, Imagine High








Imagine High Integrated Arts & Technology Secondary (9-12)

- Registration open for September 2021 now
- Max enrollment is 350
 - 175 in Grade 10
 - 145 in Grade 9 (30 from IAT cohort)
- Zoom connection to gather information about student interests, passions, learning needs, family hopes, dreams, & transitional supports
- Student recruitment to continue
- Plans underway to develop PAC & student leadership
