

# HYBRID LEARNING MODEL

## Parent Information Sheet

The hybrid learning model is a blend of online at home learning with in-class instruction. Students will cover the complete BC curriculum and will need the support of an adult, at home facilitator. The expectations and rigor of this program are high.

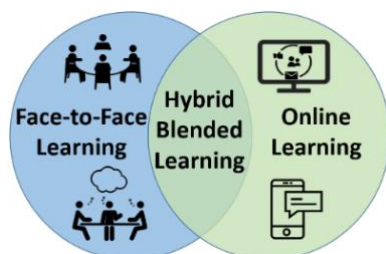
### WHAT IS THE HYBRID LEARNING MODEL?

- The hybrid learning model is the delivery of BC curriculum through a blend of in person and online learning.
- The hybrid learning model is a program of choice for middle school students (grade 6, 7, and 8).
- In the hybrid learning model students are connected to one school.
- In the hybrid learning model students attend in-class instruction two days per week, and experience remote learning three days per week.

### HOW DO I KNOW IF THE HYBRID LEARNING PROGRAM IS RIGHT FOR MY CHILD?

This offering will not be for everyone but may be the “just right” fit for some students and their families as it offers a consistent high-quality hybrid learning experience for the whole school year.

- ✓ My child excelled at remote learning but still wants to be connected to a school.
- ✓ I am able to support my child during remote learning three days per week.



### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS?

1. What sites will be used?
  - a. For the 2022/2023 school year, the program runs at Chilliwack Middle School and Vedder Middle School.
2. What days are the in-person classes going to be held?
  - a. We are prioritizing the middle of the week for these days. The days could look different at each site, but the selected days will remain consistent for the entire year.
3. What do online days look like for my students?
  - a. Each online day will have portions that students are required, (ie. Numeracy/Literacy lesson) to attend and other portion that students will have the choice to join, (ie. student support time).
4. Will there be transportation?
  - a. This is a program of choice and parents will be responsible for transportation. However, some busing may be available depending on location of students/program etc.
5. What technology is needed? Will it be provided?
  - a. A laptop (mic, camera, speakers) that is capable of online conferencing and a high-speed Internet connection is required. Ideally, each student will own their own technology.
6. Can we withdraw from the program mid-year?
  - a. Yes, however the ability to return to your catchment school will be dependent on space.
7. Can we enter the program mid-year?
  - a. Yes, dependent on space.
