

Courtesy Riders

Courtesy riders (Two Categories):

1. Conditional riders

o students living outside the walk limits but within the no ride zone and attending their catchment area school.


2. School of choice riders

 students attending a school other than their catchment school by choice (including French Immersion and International Student Program).

No additional stops will be added.

Availability

Fees apply to Courtesy riders.





Registration Fees

Courtesy rider fees for the 2024-25 school year:

- o \$295 per student
- o maximum family fee of \$590

Registration Fee:

- February May 31 (no charge)
- June 1 \$50
- o July 1 \$75





Registrations

Regular riders (4 categories):

1. Rural

- Students whose primary residence is beyond the walk limits and outside the no ride zone of their catchment area school.
- The School Locator may be used to determine walking distances to the catchment area school.

2. Overflow/alternate school


- Students asked to attend a school outside their catchment area (overflow).
- Walk limits apply.
- Schools are to coordinate with Transportation.


3. Students with disabilities or diverse abilities

Approval from Student Services

4. Special program

- Students attending special programs approved by the School Board
- Walk limits apply.







TRANSPORTATION (2 ZONES):

1. No Ride

 These are the urban areas of Chilliwack and Sardis that are typically serviced by City transit.


2. Regular Rider


• Beyond the walk limits and outside the no ride zone of their catchment area school.

WALK LIMITS (2 Groups):

- 1. K-5
 - 3.0 kilometers or less
- 2. 6 12
 - 4.0 kilometers or less


Shortest distance by public road or public walkway from the primary residence to the catchment area school.








Chilliwack School District Challenges






Building a Route






Building a Route





Chilliwack School District Transfers & Routing Challenges






Funding & Expenses
